



# installation

## Claytex®

This installation method is designed to ensure the following:

- The Claytex® is installed in accordance with the manufacturer's requirements.
- The playing surface gives consistent performance.
- That water drains freely for the life of the court.

The following assumes the installation is to be done over a base that is suitable for the purpose.

- 1 Claytex® rolls are delivered to site.
- 2 Claytex® rolls are unloaded and placed in a designated storage area.
- 3 Court lines are marked out using the L.T.A. guide for line marking. Position of the courts to be as agreed prior to installation with the client.
- 4 The sections of base where lines are to be placed are masked off using metal plates.
- 5 Rolls of surface are placed in position and precision cut where they abut adjacent rolls.
- 6 Rolls are turned back and the approved adhesive (see specification sheet) is splatter coated by spray machine onto the base.
- 7 When all rolls are laid, surface is precision cut to allow pre-cut white line kit to be glued in place using the approved adhesive applied by beading. Lines are rolled or weighted until adhesive has cured.
- 8 Edges are precision trimmed.
- 9 Rubber granules of the appropriate specification are applied and distributed at the specified rate (see specification sheet). White lines are brushed to improve visibility.
